# Five high-end homes designed by notable architects

## Penthouse, Lumina tower, San Francisco, US, \$49m

**Where** Overlooking the waterfront of San Francisco's SoMa neighbourhood, at the top of the 42-floor Lumina SF tower, 15 miles from the city's international airport.

**What** A five-bedroom duplex apartment with about 13,800 sq ft of living space. The property has a double-height living and dining area with floor-to-ceiling windows.



**Why** The building was designed by Peruvian architect Bernardo Fort-Brescia, co-founder of Arquitectonica. Known for its bold and colourful façades, the practice also designed the Banco de Credito Headquarters in Lima; the Atlantis Condominium in Miami; and The Westin hotel in New York.
