

SF Luxury Condo Now Comes With Audi Access

Need further incentive to bid on San Francisco's most expensive condominium for sale?

The 3,800 square foot duplex penthouse on the 41st and 42nd floors of the new Lumina building at 201 Folsom Street is still on the market for \$49 million.

According to the listing, the unit, which will be available to move into in summer 2016, has five bedrooms, five "entertaining rooms," six bathrooms, two half bathrooms, a gym/massage room, and family lounge. The windows are 20-foot high "shimmering walls of glass" that offer 360-degree views and there are eight exclusive-use outdoor spaces including a private rooftop terrace.

Add to those amenities Audi's new At Home car service, which will be available onsite for all Lumina residents — even the ones who paid just \$2 million to live there. According to a company press release, the Lumina and a luxury property in Miami are the first in the country to get the service.
